



NWACC Career Pathways Application and Waiting List Information

Thank you for your interest in the Career Pathways program at NWACC.

Applications for admission to the program are submitted to the state office for verification on the 15th of each month, and results are returned on or around the 30th of each month. When your application is verified eligible by the state office, your name will be placed on the waiting list.

We will contact you to schedule an intake appointment when space becomes available. While you are on the waiting list, here are some steps to look for additional resources.

1. If you have not already done so, complete the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Application if you want to take college courses. This application is separate from the Career Pathways application process, and you may qualify for a PELL grant that you could use to start college regardless of your status on the Career Pathways waiting list.
 - a. Visit the website www.fafsa.ed.gov
 - b. You will need your 2008 tax and/or income information.
 - c. Use school code 030633 to choose NWACC as the school you will attend.
 - d. Complete the online application. Make sure you apply for a PIN and use it to electronically "sign" the application.
2. If you are a single parent, contact the Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Benton County, or Washington County, to see if you qualify for assistance.
