## COLLEGE LEVEL EXAMINATION PROGRAM

*90 minute exams-instant results-year round testing*

NWACC offers the CLEP daily on a “by appointment” basis. Contact the Testing Center to make your appointment. NWACC proctor fee \$25.00, which is non-refundable; Stop by the Admissions office and let them know you are taking a CLEP exam. You will pay this fee at the Cashier’s office located across from Admissions.

CLEP test fee \$72.00 must be paid with credit card to CLEP online when you log-in to test.  
Total cost of Test is \$97.00

CLEP is an internet-based assessment of current skills for college credit.

While any CLEP test is available, currently NWACC offers credit for passing scores only on the following tests:

NWACC has established minimum CLEP scores which are equal to or greater than the minimum scores recommended by the American Council of Education (Last Revised 9/24/03)

Six month waiting period for re-testing.

## Conditions for Granting CLEP Credit:

- If a course is completed and CLEP credit is later granted for the same course, both grades will be reflected on the NWACC transcript but only the higher grade will be calculated in to the GPA.
- If CLEP credit is awarded while enrolled in same course, the course grade will override CLEP unless the course is formally dropped.
- Transfer of CLEP credit is subject to individual institutional guidelines.
