JBU requires at least 35 upper division credits; if too many such courses are taken at the community college level, it would be necessary to complete upper division electives at JBU. You may choose to take the courses at NWACC or take the equivalents at JBU and transfer the credits back to NWACC to earn the associate degree.

Any grade below a 'C' will not transfer.
