Students are highly encouraged to transfer as soon as requirements (noted below) for admission to the professional program are met. A total of 44 hours will transfer from NWACC but a student would still need a minimum of 4 years on the UAF campus to complete the degree.

*These courses are **strongly recommended** by the University of Arkansas, School of Architecture.

**College Algebra and Trigonometry are prerequisites for College Physics. College Physics is required by the University of Arkansas, School of Architecture.

Architecture Transfer Students are generally classified as Spring-Summer Studio students unless students have completed math and physics requirements. They begin the studio sequence (Design I) in the spring semester and will follow with a six-week summer course (Design II).

In order to be eligible to transfer for Spring-Summer admission, candidates must:

- Apply for admission to the University of Arkansas by November 15th of the academic year of their intended enrollment.
- Have completed at least one semester of college-level Physics and at least one semester of Advanced Math (calculus or finite math) at the time of enrollment.
- Attend an orientation session in January of the academic year of their intended enrollment.
