All pre-requisite requirements must be completed prior to beginning the nursing professional program of studies. You must apply to the nursing program at the U of A by June 15th to start in January and by December 1st to start in the fall. Students are ranked according to GPA for admission to the program.

A minimum GPA of 2.75 is required.

CPR certification is required.

Official transcripts from other institutions attended must be sent to the Eleanor Mann School of Nursing. In some instances course descriptions and/or college catalogs must be submitted before the course work can be evaluated.
