Complete Associate of Applied Science- Nursing at NWACC

Register for and pass the NLN Mobility Examination

Apply for admission and be accepted to MSSU Nursing Program

Fall Semester – Nurs 301 Transitions in Nursing (Internet). Completion of this course with a grade of “C” or above will allow credit for the following: Nurs 310 Health Assessment & Technologies, Nurs 320 Adult Nursing, Nurs350 Family Nursing, Nurs 360 Mental Health Nursing, and Nurs 400 Complex Nursing.

Complete general core curriculum.

One half or major requirements must be earned at MSSU.

Minimum of 60 semester credit hrs must be earned at MSSU or other accredited 4 year institution.

All degrees must total at least 124 hours- Additional hours may be required at MSSU.

A minimum of 40 hours must be upper (300 & 400) level- Always check for prerequisites
