

The following are the prerequisite course work for admission to the Doctor of Chiropractic program at Cleveland, Logan and Palmer Colleges. Though the pre-professional curriculum is similar for all programs in Chiropractic, the student should contact the school of their choice for specific admission requirements.

The Program

The Doctor of Chiropractic requires a minimum of 60 semester hours of pre-professional course work. The professional curriculum for most colleges is 10 trimesters. Each trimester is approximately four months long and most students complete the curriculum in three and one-third years.

Pre-Professional Curriculum

The following courses offered by the NorthWest Arkansas Community College satisfy the prerequisite course work for pre-chiropractic. A minimum grade point average of 2.25 is required with no less than a “C” grade in courses with a laboratory.

Courses

- **Biology I, Biology II or Anatomy and Physiology I and II** 8
- **College Chemistry I and II** 8
- **College Physics I and II** Prerequisite is MATH 1213 8
- **English Composition I and II** 6
- **Psychology** 3
- **Social Sciences or Humanities** 15
- **Communication** 3
- **Organic Chemistry** – Offered at a four-year school 8

When to apply

Ideally, students should apply as soon as they begin their science prerequisites but at least one year prior to the term for which they plan on being admitted.
