APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

STEPS TO ENROLL AT NWACC

1. SUBMIT APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Pay a \$10 application fee for new students or a \$5 application fee for re-admitted students at the time you submit your application (non-refundable). New international students pay a \$35 application fee (non-refundable).

2. SUBMIT PLACEMENT TEST SCORES

By state law, all students who have never attended college before must take a placement test (ACT, COMPASS, or SAT) before they enroll in college-level credit classes. You may take the COMPASS test in our Testing Center. Call 479-619-4317 or visit our website for testing hours and information.

3. SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

First-time college students: If you graduated high school after April 30, 2002, you must submit an official, complete high school transcript (or GED score report) by the first day of the semester.

Transfer college students: Submit copies of transcripts from all colleges attended if your NWACC classes require proof of prerequisites. Submit an official copy if you plan to earn a degree from NWACC or receive financial aid. Official transcripts are in a unopened envelope from the college attended.

4. SUBMIT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Full-time college students born after December 31, 1956 must submit records documenting one rubella and two measles immunizations. Submit this documentation within 30 days of the beginning of classes. The college may require additional records for international students.

5. ORIENTATION AND ACADEMIC ADVISING

First-time college students: You must complete orientation and meet with an academic advisor before registering for classes.

Transfer and previous NWACC college students: You may choose to meet with an academic advisor before registering for classes.

6. ENROLL FOR CLASSES

New college students: You will receive your PIN from your academic advisor. Your PIN will allow you to register online through My NWACC Connection at www.nwacc.edu.

Transfer and previous NWACC college students: You will receive your PIN after you submit your application. Your PIN will allow you to register online through My NWACC Connection at www.nwacc.edu.

7. PAY YOUR TUITION

You may pay your tuition using any of these methods:

- ◆ in person at the Cashiers Office
- ◆ by mail to the attention of the **Cashiers Office** at the address below
- ◆ by credit card using the web or phone the Cashiers Office at 479-619-4291
- ◆ through financial aid
- ◆ by a third party such as an employer. See Cashiers Office for details.
- ◆ by setting up a payment plan through e-Cashier via the college website.

Contact the Cashiers Office for deadline dates of tuition payments or questions about payment plans at 479-619-4291. Failure to make appropriate payment arrangements will result in being dropped from classes.

ASSOCIATE OF GENERAL STUDIES DEGREE / CERTIFICATE OF GENERAL STUDIES

The General Studies program is designed for students who wish to tailor a program to meet their personal educational enrichment goals. This degree/certificate is not designed to transfer to a bachelor's degree program nor is it designed for employment in a specific field. Rather, students work with an advisor to identify an area of emphasis and select courses that meet the student's educational needs or desires.

TRANSFER DEGREES

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS (AA) The Associate of Arts degree is a transfer degree designed for the student who wishes to major in the liberal arts. Courses taken in the approved core curriculum will also apply toward baccalaureate degree requirement at most four-year institutions.

ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (AS) The Associate of Science Degree is a transfer degree designed for the student who wishes to major in engineering, agriculture, or the sciences. The requirements for these majors are usually heavily loaded with mathematics and science courses. Courses taken in the approved core curriculum will also apply toward baccalaureate degree requirement at most four-year institutions. NWACC offers a general AS degree as well as one with emphasis in one of these areas:

- Aviation Science
- Business Emphasis
- Science Emphasis

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN TEACHING (AAT) The Associate of Arts Teaching degree is a transfer degree which comprises the general education program in the education field. Courses taken in the approved core curriculum will also apply toward baccalaureate degree requirement at most four-year institutions.
