LEGL 2713 (Bankruptcy Law)

Catalog Description:

This course presents fundamental concepts of bankruptcy law, including the different types of bankruptcies and the substantive/procedural aspects of bankruptcy petitions, hearings, discharges and remedies. Emphasis will be on the paralegal's role, and the students will become familiar with and draft necessary documentation.

Course Objectives:

- To learn the vocabulary and principles associated with bankruptcy.
- To learn who may seek bankruptcy relief, how the paralegal assists the attorney in the bankruptcy process and the steps involved from client intake to the closing of a bankruptcy case.
- To learn how to analyze client information and to prepare the documents required to file the initial bankruptcy petition with the court and to perform other legal tasks related to bankruptcy.
