Catalog Description—Development of aural perception through ear training, sight singing, and keyboard harmony

Prerequisite--MUSI 1621. It is recommended that this course be taken in conjunction with MUSI 1613, MUSIC THEORY II

Credit hours/Contact hours/Load hours—1 CREDIT HOUR / 2 CONTACT HOURS / 1 LOAD HOUR

Target Audience and Transferability--Music majors. This transfers as a 1-hour music lab course to most universities. It is required as a co-requisite with college-level Music Theory II at most schools.

Student Learning Outcomes—Students will:

- Develop skills for analyzing music form and structure
- Demonstrate improved ability to sing at sight
- Demonstrate improved music dictation skills

Topics—Notation, Rhythm, Dictation, Listening, Sightsinging, Form and structure

Forms of Assessment—Dictation test, Sightsinging test
