PEAC 2351 Intermediate Golf

Catalog description:

A continuation of the study and practice of golf fundamental with emphasis on advanced skill.

Prerequisite: PEAC 1351 or consent

Credit hours/contact hours/load hours: 1/1/1

Target Audience & Transfer:

Designed for students seeking an Associate of Arts degree and as one of the two-hour requirement options in various programs. This class may transfer to the University of Arkansas as a physical education activity elective in some colleges. The student may need to petition.

General Course Outcomes:

Students completing this course will be able to:

1. Continue to appreciate golf as a valuable lifetime leisure activity.
2. Relate with others in an environment conducive to good social adjustment
3. Demonstrate golf scoring, rules, etiquette terminology and history
4. Know how to use the proper golf swing with the appropriate club.

Required Text:

“Little Red Book” by Harvey Penick

Topics:

1. Develop a repetitive golf swing, one that will hold up in pressure situations and improve putting, chipping & wedge play.
2. Continue to appreciate golf as a valuable lifetime leisure activity.
3. Relate with others in an environment conducive to good social adjustment
4. Learn golf scoring, rules, etiquette terminology and history through class discussions, lectures, and participation.

Required Methods of Instruction:

Individual instructors may design the course in any number of ways, keeping the course objectives in mind. This is an activity class and the main objective is to encourage an active lifestyle, therefore, the instructor should participate, motivate, and make the class upbeat and fun. The main body of the class will consist of practice of golf fundamental with emphasis on advanced skill and participation at local golf courses.

Required Form of Assessment:

This activity course is designed to motivate students to appreciate golf as a lifetime sports activity, therefore, attendance and participation will be the main focus of assessment. However, there will be a final exam-covering key golfing terms and techniques from the “Little Red Book” by Harvey Penick.
