

## Testing Center Frequently Asked Questions For Accuplacer

### ❖ What are the Testing Center hours?

- They are also posted on the Testing Center door/windows.

### ❖ Where is the Testing Center located?

- The Testing Center is located in the Student Center, Room 306 (Main Campus).

### ❖ Are testing appointments necessary?

- All tests **EXCEPT** Accuplacer require an appointment to test.

### ❖ Is a photo ID necessary to take a test?

- Photo ID's are required to be admitted for **ANY** test.

### ❖ Is there a fee for the Accuplacer?

- The Accuplacer costs \$10. That fee is paid at the Treasurer's office on the second floor of the Student Center.

### ❖ Do students need to bring scratch paper, pencils, and/or calculators with them to test?

- Students are provided with scratch paper for the Accuplacer and the calculator is built into the test. **Students may NOT bring their own materials.**

### ❖ What can students do to prep for the Accuplacer?

- Accuplacer has a study app that is available for free and provides study material/practice tests for each section of the test.

### ❖ What subjects are tested on the Accuplacer?

- The Accuplacer has four parts; Math, Writing, Reading, and Listening. Most students only need the Math, Writing, and Reading.

### ❖ Is the Accuplacer timed/How long does the Accuplacer take to finish?

- The Accuplacer is an untimed exam, so how long it takes to finish is individualized.

### ❖ How long are Accuplacer scores accepted once a student takes the exam?

- Accuplacer scores are valid for 5 years. If a student's scores are older than that, they will need to retest in the sections still needed for their classes (ie if they took Comp 1 but did not take math, they will only need to retest in math).

❖ **What should a student do if they need their scores for another school?**

- If a student needs their scores for another school, they should set up a remote Accuplacer at that school and select NWACC as their testing location. A remote Accuplacer is taken at our location, but it ensures that the student is given the sections of the exam that their intended school accepts and their scores are automatically sent to that school.
