****Before you can enroll in the EMT-Basic Course, the following items must be turned into the Health Professions Office, location BH 2450B:***

— **EMT Application**

- **Documentation of current CPR certification.** The certification must be either an American Heart Association Health Care Provider Card or American Red Cross Professional Rescuer Card. The certification must be current through the completion of the EMT course.

- **Documentation of current (1 year or less) TB Skin Test Results;** the documentation must be current through completion of EMT course. If you need to obtain a current TB Skin Test, it may require 2 skin tests and could take up to two weeks to complete. The 2nd TB Skin Test is required before the first day of class. Contact your family physician or county health department for more information.

- **Documentation of an approved First Responder Course.** If you took this course at NWACC, list that information on the last page of this application. If you took the course elsewhere, please include a copy of the course certificate, card, or transcript.

***Due to the limited number of seats in the program and the high volume of applicants, attempts at taking the program are limited to two times. Students will not be allowed to enroll in the course until these documents are turned into the Health Professions Division Office.**

The letter of authorization should contain the following information:

- 1. Student's name**
- 2. Student's social security number**
- 3. Third party name and address (letterhead is sufficient)**
- 4. Detail of covered expense (tuition, books, supplies, etc)**
- 5. Maximum dollar amount**
