If you feel that your child meets the qualifications listed below and would like to apply for tuition assistance, please fill out the form below and submit, along with your child's Career Camp 2009 registration form, no later than May 12, 2009. Students may qualify for WIB Youth Programs Tuition Assistance if they meet the age criteria along with one or more of the following criteria:

1. Student must be 14 years of age or older. (This criterion must be met.)
2. Family income level at or below poverty level. (\$10,830 for family of one, \$14,570 for family of two, \$18,310 for family of three, \$22,000 for family of four, \$25,000 for family of 5, \$29,000 for family of 6)
3. Family is currently receiving food stamps or a parent or guardian is currently depending upon SSI for income.
4. Foster children, children living in guardianship situations, or children identified with special needs by their schools may qualify regardless of income level.
