

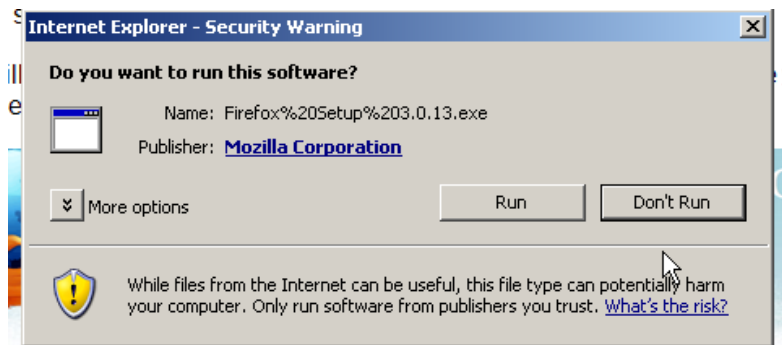
Installing Mozilla Firefox 3.0

Firefox is another type of browser that you can use for Blackboard and for the internet. **Currently, Blackboard does not support the newest Firefox version 3.5, but rather the earlier version 3.0.**

1. Go to: <http://www.mozilla.com/en-US/firefox/all-older.html>
2. Scroll down to choose the English (US) row and click the one that matches your operating system [most people use Windows or Mac].
3. You will be prompted to click Run. There are also instructions on the page visible behind the gray box.



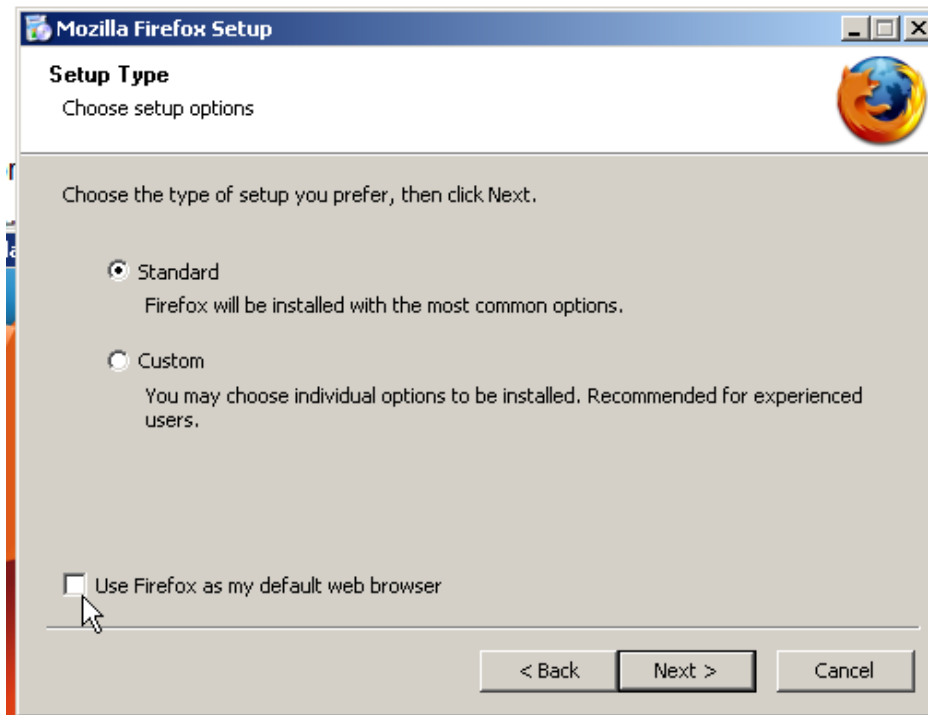
You might also be prompted to click another gray box – click Run. You might also be prompted to close any other windows and/or programs you have running.



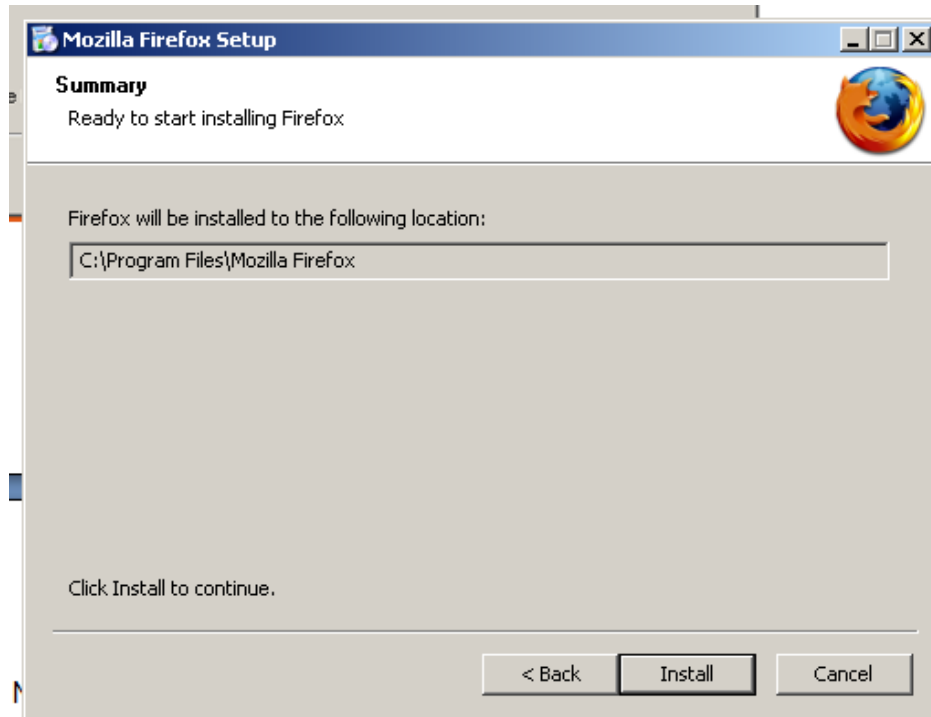
4. The program will extract and bring up the Firefox Setup Wizard. Click Next



5. Keep the Standard setup. If you want to use Firefox as your main internet browser, keep the lower box checked. If you plan to use Firefox only for Blackboard, un-check the box. Click Next.



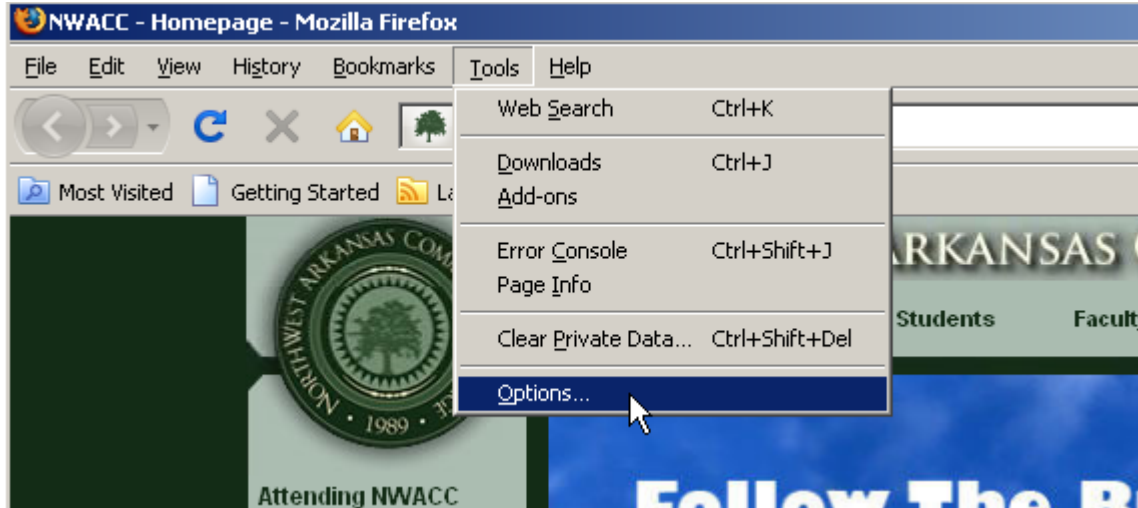
6. Keep the default installation location and click Install.



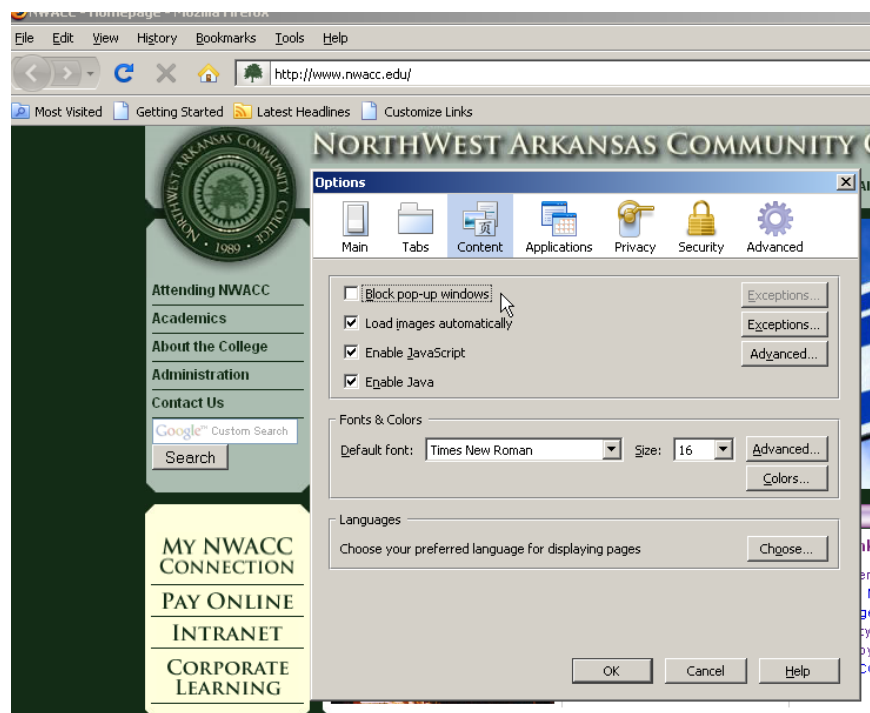
7. You will see an install bar, and then get a confirmation screen. Keep the box checked. Click Finish.



8. Firefox will launch, then go to **Tools > Options** on the top bar.



9. Go to the Content tab and UN-check the box for “Block pop-up windows”. Click OK.



10. Go to <http://nwacc.blackboard.com> and click on the [Check Browser](#) link in the upper right corner of the screen. Hopefully everything will come up with a green check!
