

How to Access your Distance Learning Classes

Most distance learning classes at NWACC use **Blackboard CE** as the primary online learning system.

Blackboard CE can be entered by using [Option 1] the links inside My **NWACC Connection**, or by logging in directly at the Blackboard portal page [Option 2].

Non-Blackboard Online Systems

Some distance learning classes at NWACC use other online systems. This is especially true for **math classes**.

If you are taking an online class that does not use Blackboard, please contact your instructor **immediately** to find out what other system you will be using.

Access Codes

Some distance learning courses require you to purchase an access code to gain entry to the online class materials.

Your instructor or the NWACC Bookstore will be able to tell you if an access code is required for your specific course.

Option 1: Enter Blackboard CE through My NWACC Connection

The easiest way to find your Blackboard classes is from inside My NWACC Connection.

1. **Log into My NWACC Connection.** If you do not know how to do this, or need help with your username or password, please call **Student Records** at 479-619-4398.
2. Go to the **My Courses** tab. Set the dropdown box to the correct semester:
3. Click on the name of the course to go straight into Blackboard.

Option 2: Login to Blackboard at the **NWACC Online Portal Page**

It is also possible to login directly to the Blackboard portal page to access your Blackboard classes.

1. Call **Student Records** at 479-619-4398 to get your **PIN** for Blackboard.
2. Go to <http://nwacc.blackboard.com>
3. Your **User name** will be the same as for **My NWACC Connection**.
4. The PIN obtained from **Student Records** will be your **Password**

NWACC Online

The primary way to enter your online classes should be through **My NWACC Connection [MNC]**, using the link on the My Courses tab. This login screen is provided as a convenience if the MNC system is not accessible via normal means, or if you have been given access as a guest.

Your **User Name** is the same as your login name for My NWACC Connection. However, your **Password** will be a 6-digit **PIN** [your EagleNet Pin], **not** the password you use for My NWACC Connection. If you do not have this information, please contact Student Records for more information below.
