TITLE: PT Physical Science



Specific Duties:

Teach any physical science courses for which qualified (see qualifications below). Physical science courses include: Astronomy, Chemistry, Geology, and General Physical Science. Faculty must prepare presentations and learning activities that help students accomplish the learning outcomes (and follow any other guidelines) stated in the standard course outlines. This includes creating exams, quizzes, assignments, and lab activities that stimulate and assess student learning. Faculty are expected to prepare a syllabus that describes the course objectives, topics, grading, and class policies. Faculty must participate in any department or course specific learning assessment in addition to course and performance related evaluations. Science faculty teach and manage their own lab sections.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's degree with at least 15 graduate hours related to the course taught. Work or other related experience may be substituted for some graduate hours upon approval.

Preferred Knowledge or Experience:

Teaching experience at secondary or college level is desirable. Knowledge of safe handling of chemical and/or biological hazards in the lab is a plus.
