

AFLS 1002 Careers in Agriculture, Food, and Life Sciences

Catalog Description: An introductory course to the depth and breadth of career opportunities in agricultural, food and life sciences. Students will use the internet as a resource for career information, and to communicate about career options, job placement, and job opportunities.
