Art History I introduces the student to art forms from the Stone Age through the Middle Ages.

Target Audience/Transferability:

This course is designed for students seeking an optional fine arts elective for NWACC's Associate of Arts Degree and transfers to the University of Arkansas in lieu of the university's Art History Survey II.

Learning Outcomes:

- Identify and discuss selected works of art from prehistoric times to the Middle Ages
- Connect art and creative processes to social, cultural, and historical issues.
- Identify and explain the terms, methods, and modes of expression in media pertinent to the periods.
- Analyze and critique various art works through written and/or oral analysis.
- Use basic research skills in art history.
