Enhance the use of materials, procedures, subject matter and approaches to painting.

Target Audience/Transferability

Designed for art students transferring to art programs of four- year colleges and working toward a Bachelor Degree in Art, or for students completing the art requirements for the two-year NWACC Associate of Applied Science Degree in Graphic Design. Successful completion of this course should prepare students for further study in the art and design fields. ART 2113 transfers to the University of Arkansas as an elective.

Student Learning Outcomes

Students completing this course will:

- Apply improved painting skills and techniques
- Demonstrate improved design and composition skills
- Discuss various painting techniques used in a work of art and describe how they contribute to the value of art

Topics

Subjects will be chosen from (but not limited to) the following:

- Various methods of enlargement and transferring images
- Classical study
- Experiment in composition
- Selection and framing
- Organization and display
- Due to the variety of time periods needed by advanced students to complete large-scale projects, the course may become more of an independent study for highly disciplined students. The group may come together from time to time to pursue subjects of mutual interest (field trips, painting a model, etc.).
