Course is designed for students who have completed all pre-requisites prior to the FAA Private Pilot Check-ride. Flight examination will be performed by an independent FAA certified official. Will transfer to Henderson State University and most other four year institutions which offer a Bachelor's in Aviation Science.

Students completing this course will be able to:

1. Exercise all the rights and privileges allowable to the holder of the FAA Private Pilot License (safely operate a single engine aircraft in visual flight conditions).
2. Further training toward advanced FAA Pilot Licensure.
