COMM 2612, Introduction to Speech Competition

Through preparation of public address and oral interpretation presentations, students gain speaking and performance skills through competition on NWACC's Forensics team. Students participate in at least 2 tournaments during the semester. Additionally, one public on campus showcase during the semester is required.

Target Audience/Transferability

This course is designed for communication majors, as well as students that desire to increase their opportunities in the job market by demonstrating effective public speaking skills. The course may transfer as a required course for a communication major and/or as an elective for both communication majors and non-majors.

Topics

Informative, persuasive, demonstration speeches, group speeches, verbal, nonverbal, communication analysis, prose, poetry, extemporaneous speaking, impromptu speaking, and interpretative theatre.

Assessment

- A minimum of 5 oral presentations
- Library research

- Written analyses of literature and written outlines of speeches

Required Materials

Attend a minimum of one off campus speech team competition. Travel may include overnight.
