Course Number and Title

EMTP 1111, EMS Environment I

Prerequisite

Students entering in this class must be accepted by the Allied Health Department and enrolled into the paramedic program. Only students in the paramedic program are allowed to participate in this course.

Course Description

An overview of areas of pre-hospital environment are covered. Included are medical ethics, professionalism, legal considerations by the paramedic, duty to act, and scope of duties performed by the paramedic.

Target Audience

This course is designed for individuals enrolled in the paramedic program who desire to become certified as a paramedic. This course does not transfer unless the institution approves it. Students wishing to transfer this course should check ahead of time with the other institution to ascertain the transferability of this course.
