Course Number and Title--MUSI 1512 Private Organ

Catalog Description—(F, S) One hour private lesson per week; extra fee charged. May be repeated for credit.

Prerequisites—MUSI 1232 or consent of instructor

Credit hours/Contact hours/Load hours--2 Credit/ 1 Contact / 1 Load

Target Audience and Transfer--This course is designed as an introduction to the organ for transfer students and transfers as an elective for non-music majors or as a requirement for organ majors. Transferability varies from institution to institution. (Students should contact target institutions for transferability.) The course is also structured to appeal to community members who want private organ lessons.

Learning Outcomes--Students completing this course will

- show a beginning-level knowledge of the organ, notation, and pedal techniques.
- demonstrate an ability to perform before a live audience.

Topics—Notation, Rhythm, Musical expressions, Scales registrations, Stylistic interpretation, Pedal techniques

Forms of Assessment—Periodic and end-of-term playing tests. Each student registered for credit for this course will be required to play a final jury for members of the music faculty.
