

## STANDARD COURSE OUTLINE

### **PHTA 2352            Clinical Experience II**

**PREREQUISITE**    Successful completion of fall PHTA classes. Must have “C” average in all the following courses prior to beginning clinical assignment: PHTA 2301, PHTA 2302, PHTA 2321, PHTA 2322, PHTA 2342, PHTA 2341, PHTA 2332.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION**    A three week clinical assignment in a physical therapy setting. This course is designed to provide clinical experience utilizing skills obtained in the didactic and lab courses. The student will perform technical skills which they have shown competency in the lab setting under personal supervision progressing to clinical supervision as determined by the Clinical Instructor.

**CREDIT HOURS**            2 credit hours / non-transferable

### **INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS**

Required: Two copies of the Clinical Performance Instrument

### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

Upon successful completion of this course, the student should be able to:

1. Participate in an orientation of the department and hospital as determined by the facility.
2. Perform duties in a safe manner that minimizes risk to patient, self, and others.
3. Conduct self in a responsible manner in the clinical setting.
4. Interact with others in a respectful manner in the clinical setting.
5. Adhere to ethical standards in the clinical setting.
6. Adhere to legal standards in the clinical setting.
7. Communicate in ways that are congruent with situational needs as appropriate for initial clinical experience.
8. Produce documentation to support the delivery of physical therapy services.
9. Perform physical therapy interventions in a technically competent manner with a non-complex patient population.
10. Manage resources to achieve goals of the clinical setting.
11. Provide inservice appropriate to the clinical setting in a concise and organized manner.
12. Present patient case to class upon completion of clinical experience.
13. Performance of the criteria #1-5 listed in the Clinical Performance Instrument in the upper 4<sup>th</sup> quartile of the visual analog scale.
14. Performance of the criteria #6-20 listed in the Clinical Performance Instrument in the upper 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quartile (average).
