An introductory course in the basic elements of lighting, scenery, properties, costume, and makeup design for the stage. Production work hours may be required.

This course is designed to introduce basic elements of lighting, scenery, and props design for the theatre. This course is required for the Associate of Fine Arts Degree and may transfer to other institutions to fulfill a theatre major or humanities requirement.

Student Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of this course, students will:

- Identify design fundamentals of scenery, lighting, and prop location and construction.
- Recognize and demonstrate safety requirements in using types of scenery and lighting equipment.
- Compose plans and renderings for scenery.
- Create lighting plots and cue sheets.
- Demonstrate ability to locate and/or construct props.

Topics

Types of scenery and scene supplies, lighting instruments and operation, use of color in design, safety in the theatre, properties.

Assessment

- A journal of the design process.
- A minimum of one scenery project to include floor plans, elevations, and other renderings of a set with furniture.
- A minimum of one lighting design, including the plot and cue sheets.
- Master property list, including any constructed props.
