Steps to transfer to MSSU:

- 1. Apply for admission to MSSU the semester prior to attending: https://admissions.mssu.edu/admissions-transfer-student.php
- 2. Send all transcripts to MSSU. Contact <u>admissions@mssu.edu</u> if you need help with sending transcripts.
- 3. Call or email MSSU Teacher Education at <u>Vieselmeyer-j@mssu.edu</u> or 417-659-4318 for plan of study and enrollment.
- 4. The student will sign an attestation: acknowledgment that MSSU's Teacher Education Program does not include the required History of Arkansas course necessary for Licensure by Reciprocity from Missouri certification to Arkansas certification. Students are required to take the History of Arkansas course prior to transfer, apply for Missouri Certification through Department of Elementary and Secondary Education upon graduation from MSSU then apply for Licensure by Reciprocity through Arkansas Department of Education.
