4. The student will sign an attestation: acknowledgment that MSSU's Teacher Education Program does not include the required History of Arkansas course necessary for Licensure by Reciprocity from Missouri certification to Arkansas certification. Students are required to take the History of Arkansas course prior to transfer, apply for Missouri Certification through Department of Elementary and Secondary Education upon graduation from MSSU then apply for Licensure by Reciprocity through Arkansas Department of Education.

Student Teaching Semester Admission: Professional GPA 3.0, Content GPA 3.0, take the Praxis, all other coursework completed, approved background check.

Degree Completion: Content GPA 3.0, PASS all required Praxis exams, PASS MEES

Missouri Certification: PASS all required Praxis exams; PASS MEES, Updated fingerprints/FBI background check, Application submitted to DESE

If choosing to teach in Arkansas: will need to apply for Licensure by Reciprocity on dese.ade.arkansas.gov at end of student teaching semester
