Below are the prompts for your essay. This is a required part of the application and you will not be placed on the interview list until it has been received. Your essay is uploaded as either a pdf or jpeg file to the same dropbox as your application.

Please select one of the discussion questions below and answer it in your own handwriting. Be thorough but you don't have to write a book! 2-3 paragraphs is appropriate.

1. Everyone has their own story, sometimes you feel your story identifies you to such a degree that only when people know your story can they really understand you. If this is you, tell me your story.
2. Everyone is a collection of their personal experiences, good, bad, setbacks, accomplishments, failures, and successes. Describe an event in your life that fits this description and how it affects your choice of career field and your academic abilities.
3. Tell me about your favorite academic subject and why you like that subject. What kind of academic challenges have you encountered and how has that affected your view of the education process?
