RFP-22-007 Camera & Recording System: Questions & Answers

Q: We noticed that only one camera per room is required. This means the five interview rooms will have only one camera. Interview rooms typically have two cameras: a dome or PTZ as well as a covert camera. Is there no need for a covert camera in these rooms?

A: Correct, no need for a covert camera for our purposes.

Q: Q&A Question: "Q: In which locations will HDMI encoders for screen/presentation capture be required and quantities? A: We need to be able to record from all cameras.":

An HDMI encoder can be used to capture a video feed from a screen or monitor in synchronization with the camera system. To quote this as an add-on, we need to know what rooms and quantities of the encoders are needed?

A: One encoder should be sufficient.

Q: Please confirm if the vendor or NWACC will be responsible for removal of all existing cabling. In these two Q&As, one says removal of wiring, and the other says no.

A: Committee is differentiating between wiring and cabling. Since NWACC and the vendor might not have the same definition, can the vendor supply a quote with removal and one without?
