## National Update

**71 positive cases in Benton County/ 62 positive cases in Washington County**

First 2 COVID-19 related deaths reported in Washington County.

**Positive Cases: 2,741 Active Cases: 1,763**  
**AR has reported 46 deaths related to COVID-19; 932 recoveries**

2,808 tests have been processed in AR within the last 24 hours.

### **2 DAY ARKANSAS SURGE CAMPAIGN- APRIL 24 & 25**
