KNOW WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY



LOCKDOWN (Run, Hide, Fight)

WHEN: YOU WILL RECEIVE THIS NOTICE IF THERE IS AN ACTIVE SHOOTER OR OTHER VIOLENCE ON CAMPUS

ACTIONS: Depending on the situation: **run** away, or **hide** where you are, under furniture; lock or barricade doors; turn out lights; remain quiet. As a last resort **fight** to defend yourself.

Call NWACC DPS 479-619-4229 or 911 if you have information for the police.

Warn others if possible.



EVACUATE

WHEN: YOU WILL RECEIVE THIS NOTICE IF THERE IS DANGER INSIDE OR NEAR THE BUILDING

ACTIONS: Leave the building - do not use elevators.

Take your cell phone and valuables with you, but only when safe.

Proceed to safe area outside.

Wait for official notice before attempting to re-enter the building.



SEEK SHELTER

WHEN: SEVERE WEATHER OR AN ENVIRONMENTAL DANGER OUTSIDE

ACTIONS: Seek shelter inside a designated area and remain there.

Warn others if possible.

Wait for official notice to resume normal activities.

HOW WILL INFORMATION BE COMMUNICATED?

NWACC utilizes multiple redundant systems to disseminate emergency communications:

- LiveSafe Smartphone App (receive alerts, report concerns, call and text with DPS)
- Alert:me (Benton County ALERT text messaging system)
- Mass Emergency Notification System boards located throughout campus
- Office Speaker Phones
- Fmai
- Social Media (Facebook & Twitter)
- Department of Public Safety Officers
