

Arkansas Community Colleges 2019 All-Star Student Program

Purpose:

The purpose of this program is to recognize the scholarly and service achievements of Arkansas' two-year college students. The NorthWest Arkansas Community College (NWACC) All-Star will be recognized at the Arkansas Community College (ACC) All-Star Awards Brunch in October in Little Rock, Arkansas. The NWACC All-Star will receive a \$500 scholarship after attending the ACC All-Star Awards Brunch.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

- Arkansas resident
- Enrolled at NWACC and expected to continue enrollment through at least Fall 2019
- Completed a minimum of 24 credit hours in pursuit of an associate degree by June 1, 2019
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.25
- Demonstrated involvement in campus and/or community activities
- Intent to graduate from NWACC with an associate degree by Summer 2020
- Intent to transfer to an Arkansas four-year university upon associate degree completion

How to Apply:

- 1) Complete and print the application below.
- 2) Write an essay on the topic below that is 500 words or less, typed, double-spaced and 12-point font.
 - Topic: Your most meaningful education experience while attending NWACC
- 3) Select two (2) officials (professor, advisor, or other) to write letters of recommendation on your behalf. **Remind them that their letters need to support your leadership and or college/community service abilities.** Ask them to seal these letters in an envelope and give to you.
- 4) Submit **all** of the above to Regina Johns in the Student Center, Office 213C by **Monday, March 11, 2019**. Incomplete packets will not be eligible.
