- 1**  **Activate & Secure Your NWACC Account** Log in using the instructions in your "Welcome to NWACC!" email and set up Multifactor Authentication! For help logging in, contact the [NWACC IT Help Desk](#).
- 2**  **Student Onboarding** Complete Student Onboarding in Workday. Onboarding helps you to set up your Student Account and prepare for Registration. [Review this Step-By-Step Guide](#).
- 3**  **Student Orientation** Your first step to registering for classes! Orientation is mandatory for all first-time college students. Access it through Student Onboarding or [on our website](#).
- 4**  **Official College Transcript(s) & College-Credit Scores (AP, CLEP)** Send your official college transcripts and AP, CLEP, or Dantes score reports to NWACC. Have electronic transcripts sent directly from your previous college to records@nwacc.edu.
- 5**  **Student Registration** First-time college students will register for classes with an Advisor after completing Orientation. Find your Advisor in Workday using this [this Step-By-Step Guide](#).

- 1**  **Review your NWACC Statement** 24-Hours after registering, review your NWACC Statement using this [Step-By-Step Guide](#). Please review your statement carefully and contact NWACC with any questions!
- 2**  **Pay your NWACC Bill** After reviewing your NWACC statement, choose to: pay in full, set up a payment plan, or use financial aid/scholarships. Don't forget—payments made after the due date will incur a \$50 fee! Use this [Step-By-Step Guide](#) to review your NWACC Payment.
- 3**  **Complete your Financial Aid Action Items** If you applied for Federal Financial Aid, review your Financial Aid Action Items in Workday using this [Step-By-Step Guide](#) and complete any required tasks.
- 4**  **Review your Financial Aid Offers** If you applied for Federal Financial Aid, use this [Step-By-Step Guide](#). NWACC can guide you on how much of your loan offers to accept!
- 5**  **Bookmark Canvas for Online Courses** If you're registered for Online, Live Streaming, or Hybrid courses, head to Canvas and bookmark the link for easy access! Visit <https://nwacc.instructure.com/>

- 7**  **Review your Textbooks & Course Materials** Some courses require specific textbooks and materials. After registering, visit www.nwaccbookstore.com to check the required and recommended materials for your courses.
- 8**  **Get your Student ID Card & Parking Pass** Once you're registered for courses, you can get your Student ID Card, which grants access to campus resources and local discounts. A [Parking Pass](#) is required to park at any NWACC location, including for testing or advisor meetings.
